I must report this job is going well. I have made verbal contact with 4 of the 6 manors/residences so far that I am responsible for and have received helpful and cheery greetings and offers to help.

Veterans Service Officer:

I spoke with a veteran who was being discharged from hospital and there was a lag in his benefits from Veterans Affairs Canada (VAC) kicking in. I spoke with the provincial service officer and in the meantime the veteran solved his problem with VAC. Veteran was looking for things like a walker and reaching assist to rent or borrow. He remembered a time when these things were available to sign out however due to liability issues the RCL has gone away from keeping these things on hand.

As a point of information for members, not all veterans have same level of benefits from VAC and thus it is important to keep sending any questions my way. This particular person had full (100%) coverage from Veterans Affairs through the VIP or Veterans Independence Program and Blue Cross, however not all veterans have this and we must keep our ears open for those who may fall through the cracks or who may need short term assistance to bridge other benefits they may have on an individually considered basis.
